IRS FORM 990-N FILING REQUIREMENT

The deadline for filing the IRS Form 990-N (e-Postcard) is approaching for those Sections and Chapters who are required to file it. U.S. Sections and Chapters that are not required to file (and are not filing) the "paper" Form 990 or 990-EZ are subject to the online-only filing requirement. Since all Sections and Chapters should be following The Ninety-Nines, Inc. fiscal year end of May 31, the report is due October 15, 2009. If any Sections or Chapters are using a different fiscal year end for tax purposes, the report would be due the 15th of the fifth month after their fiscal year end (4½ months).

2009-2010 MEMBERSHIP DIRECTORY CHOICES

In our ongoing effort to provide members with the best information and still keep expenses in line, a CD version of the Membership Directory will be sent to all members. A printed version will be available for \$15, but you must contact Headquarters no later than November 15, 2009 if you would prefer to receive your Directory in this format.

The CD version of the 2009-2010 Membership Directory not only has everything provided in the printed version, but also has the advantage of being easily searchable. This allows you to simply type in the name of a person, or a keyword, hit "search" and there it is! Definitely a time-saving feature.

Remember, to receive the CD version, you need do nothing, but you must contact Headquarters by November 15, 2009 and send \$15 to receive the printed version.
