Continental Airport Express offers daily, door-to-door service to/from O'Hare Airport and most city neighborhoods AND to/from Midway Airport and the city. The hours of operation for both airports are from 6 am to 11:30 pm.

The O'Hare shuttle departs approximately every 5 to 10 minutes outside the baggage claim areas on the Lower Level of the Domestic and International Terminals. The fare to the city is approximately \$25.00.

Midway departures are about every 15 minutes. It is recommended that you call Continental directly at the numbers below for specific departure information. The fare to the city is approximately \$19.00. An information counter is located at Lower Level Arrivals door LL3. The pickup location is located outside door LL3, inside lane.
