ANNUAL CONFERENCE REPORT

Kudos go to the North Central Section for providing a perfect location for the 2009 Conference. Conference Chairmen Rita Adams and Ellen O'Hara stepped up to the plate and coordinated a Conference that 'wowed' those in attendance.

Delegates representing 15 Sections from the U.S. and other countries had lively discussions about the proposed Bylaw and Standing Rules amendments and other issues. Following is a summary of the highlights of the meeting.

All proposed Bylaw and Standing Rules amendments were approved. Section 4 of proposed Bylaw Amendment #2 was amended to remove the deletion of Academic members and led to the deletion of the Proviso on proposed Standing Rule Amendment #2.

The new 99s website is up and running. The *99 News* will be posted on the public section.

For the 2009-2010 year, a CD of the Directory will be mailed to members. Members who prefer not to receive a CD should let Headquarters know. The sleeve of the CD will contain information about ordering a printed Directory at a cost of \$15. The following phone numbers will be published in the Directory – home, cell and work.
